### An easy to manage intermediate heading variety

ALUTUS starts very early in spring, and ensures a stable production with a spring window of about 55 days allowing conservation as well as grazing.

### Diploid = high drymatter %

ALUTUS being diploid, covers the ground very well and conservation as hay or silage is facilitated by the high dry matter percent.

### Quality - even in summer and autumn

ALUTUS stands out with the high summer production. This is even more valuable due to the excellent rust resistance.
